

2025 Key Dates

January – Members appointed to congressional committees.

January – Debt limit suspension ended. Treasury begins using extraordinary measures to meet its obligations for several months. The X date is unknown but likely mid-summer.

Week of January 27– House Republicans member retreat.

January 28– Special Election primaries in Florida for seats vacated by former Representatives Matt Gaetz and Michael Waltz.

February 3 – President’s budget “due” to Congress.

March 4 – President invited to address a joint session of Congress.

March 14 – FY’25 Continuing Resolution (CR) expires.

March 14 – TANF, National Flood Insurance Program, Commodity Futures Trading Commission Whistleblower Program and National Cybersecurity Protection System Authorization expire.

March 31 – Expiration of various health care extenders. Public health extenders include community health centers, National Health Service Corps, and teaching health centers that operate GME. Medicare extenders include telehealth flexibilities, hospital at home, low-volume hospital payments, Medicare-dependent hospital program, add-on payments for ambulance services, and the work geographic index floor. An elimination of Medicaid disproportionate share hospital payment cuts will also expire.

April 1 – Election day (special) in Florida for Gaetz and Waltz seats.

April 15 – “Deadline” for Congressional adoption of budget resolution.

May 1 – Fiscal Responsibility Act penalty for use of a CR in FY’25 takes effect, reducing defense and nondefense spending by 1 percent if appropriations bills are not enacted.

August 4 -September 1 – August recess.

September 30 – Expiration of statutory spending caps on discretionary spending enacted in the Fiscal Responsibility Act.

September 30- Potential FY25 budget reconciliation instructions expire.

September 30 – Farm bill and agricultural programs, including crop insurance, nutrition programs like SNAP, and agricultural conservation and research programs extensions expire.

October 1 – FY'26 begins.

December 31 – Expiration of many provisions of the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act. Expiration of enhanced ACA subsidies.

December 31 – Agricultural commodity programs expire.
